- Icebreaker activity to engage students
- Review session goals and expectations
- Confirm peer exam consent
- Instructor-led live demo with commentary on:
 - Technique
 - Hygiene
 - Rapport-building
 - Documentation best practices

0:20 – 0:50 | Peer-to-Peer Hands-On Practice (Part 1)

- Students pair up for hands-on practice
- Use structured evaluation checklist
- Focus on oral-facial structure identification and technique

0:50 – 0:55 | Midpoint Skill Check & Confidence Poll

- Brief skill check observed by trainer or peer using rubric
- Focus on:
 - Structure identification accuracy
 - Hygiene adherence
 - Verbal instruction clarity
- Confidence poll via QR code or paper:
 - Rate confidence level (1–5)
 - Identify unclear steps

0:55 – 1:15 | Data Break + Self-Review

- 20 minutes for self-assessment and reflection
- Identify personal strengths and areas needing improvement
- Review skill check results and confidence poll data (faculty/trainers)

1:15 – 1:45 | Targeted Coaching & Practice (Part 2)

- Instructor provides targeted feedback based on midpoint data
- Resume peer practice integrating coaching points
- Focus on refining skills and addressing gaps
